Guidelines for Authors

1 Purpose of the series

The Hitotsubashi Institute for Advanced Study (HIAS) Discussion Paper Series aims to provide authors with a wide audience and the opportunity to receive comments on their papers.

2 Copyright and Reserved Right

- 2.1 Copyright remains with the authors of individual papers. Any opinions expressed in the paper are those of the authors and do not necessarily represent those of HIAS.
- 2.2 Authors accept that HIAS reserves the right to submit the papers to the Hitotsubashi University repository service (HERMES-IR) and in the database of Research Papers in Economics (RePEc).
- 2.3 Authors accept the abstracts of the papers published in HERMES-IR might be provided to/used by third parties who provide database services. (The declarations are required in case authors don't accept it.)

3 Eligibility

- 3.1 Any person who has worked as a faculty of HIAS may submit a paper for publication in the series. This would include those who are HIAS Fellow and HIAS Postdoctoral Fellow.
- 3.2 Any person who has worked on Research Projects on Priority Area at HIAS as a project member or as a research collaborator or any person who has worked as a HIAS Visiting Scholar may submit a paper for publication in the series. The research collaborator should attach a letter of recommendation from a project member for the submission.
- 3.3 Any paper presented at an event organized by HIAS is eligible to be submitted with approval from the event organizer.
- 3.4 Papers already appearing as journal articles are not eligible.

4 Style

- 4.1 Papers should be written in English.
- 4.2 All papers should include an abstract as well as keywords.
- 4.3 Any author mentioned in 3-1 shall include "Hitotsubashi Institute for Advanced Study, Hitotsubashi University" as the affiliation. Authors mentioned in 3-2 and 3 should create an Acknowledgements section and describe the contribution of "Hitotsubashi Institute for Advanced Studies, Hitotsubashi University".
- 4.4 The author shall submit an electronic copy of the paper in PDF to the HIAS Planning Office. If any correction is required for conformity to the style mentioned in 4-1, 2, and 3, the author shall resubmit the revised version in PDF or editable manuscript quickly.
- 4.5 The series will be numbered consecutively. A cover page with the consecutive

number will be attached to the paper.

- 4.6 The series will only be published electronically.
- 4.7 On principle, publication date shall correspond to the submission date.

5 Replacement and withdrawal

The HIAS will respond to the author's request for replacement or withdrawal of a paper appropriately.
